IMPORTANT NOTE

Before this licence can be issued, the attached FIM medical history form must be completed by both the rider and their doctor (who must sign and stamp the form).

The completion of this form is mandatory for riders taking part in FIM International or FIM World Championship events.

Qualifications Necessary for a Driver's/Passengers Licence

A licence will be issued provided the applicant is qualified to hold a licence of the type requested. The general qualifications for each type of licence are as follows:

**TRIALS ,SHORT CIRCUITS,
MOTOCROSS, SUPERMOTO,
ENDURO
ROAD RACES**

Licence issued on the approval of the Centre which granted the applicant's National Licence.

Drivers must have gained 30 points during the previous two seasons based on the following:

Road Races (Irish Championships)

1 st – 3 rd on full race distance	15 points
4 th – 7 th on full race distance	12 points
8 th – 10 th on full race distance	8 points
11 th – 15 th on full race distance	6 points
Finisher on full race distance	3 points

Short Circuit (Irish Championships)

1 st – 3 rd on full race distance	12 points
4 th – 7 th on full race distance	8 points
8 th – 10 th on full race distance	4 points
Finisher on full race distance	2 points
