REGULATIONS:

This event will be held under the General Competition Rules of the Motorcycle Union of Ireland and the Standing Regulations for Motocross, together with the following supplementary regulations and any others subsequently issued.

1. Eligibility: Open to M.C.U.I. (U/C &S/C), M.R.A., A.C.U, and S.A.C.U licence holders and EU A&B licence holders. All non M.C.I/MRA licence holders must have personal accident insurance confirmed by their own FMN.

2. Times: Check-in and Scrutiny Riders Briefing	Practice	Racing	
08.30am Sharp	09.30am	10.00am	11.30am.

Competitors must ensure they avail of their practice session/s.

If sign-on and scrutiny has closed it will be re-opened only on payment of a fee of €15.00.

3. At "Check in" Competition Licences must be presented and the declaration form signed. One event licences may be obtained on production of a valid medical certificate or proof of having previously obtained a 1 event licence this year.

Riders not in possession of a valid licence will not be accepted.

4. Only M.C.U.I. approved helmets (stamped "2017") and clothing permitted.

5. It is the drivers responsibility to present and maintain their machines in a race worthy condition.

6. Unnecessary or inconsiderate riding in the paddock or spectator areas is prohibited and may entail disqualification from the event.

7. Drivers ignoring flag or other official signals may be penalised. Drivers who deliberately cut the course or knock down course markers will be disqualified.

8. Starting will be by "Clutch Start" controlled by a mechanical gate or other approved apparatus.

9. All machines must display three correct and legible riding numbers and be fitted with transponders.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: A fire extinguisher must be available for each machine. Petrol supplies in metal containers only.

11. Competitors may be required to provide Marshals for this event.

12. The promoters reserve the right to refuse an entry, to alter or cancel the foregoing and to issue additional supplementary regulations.

13. Riders must ensure they avail of a practice session (1 free lap plus 10 minutes timed qualifying)
