The course will be a combination of farmland, farmlanes mature woodland and fire roads, with a lap time of approximately 25 minutes and a total running time for each category of approximately 3.00hrs. Quads and Bikes will be run separately.

If check in closed it will be re-opened only on payment of a fee of €15.00.

- At "Check in" the declaration form must be signed.
- Only M.C.U.I. approved helmets (stamped "2017") and clothing permitted.
- Machines must conform to the MCUI requirements for this type of event, motocross and enduro bikes sport and farm quad will be accepted. It is the drivers responsibility to present and maintain their machines in a race worthy condition. Machines must pass Scrutiny if not riders **cannot** ride.
- Unnecessary or inconsiderate riding in the paddock or spectator areas is prohibited and may entail disqualification from the event.
- Drivers ignoring flag or other official signals may be penalised. **Drivers who are found to have deliberately cut the course WILL be disqualified.**
- SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: 1) Petrol supplies in metal containers only. 2) Refuelling is only permitted in the designated area. 3) A fire extinguisher must be available for each machine.
- Wexford Off Road Motorcycle Club Ltd reserves the right to refuse an entry, to alter or cancel the foregoing and to issue additional supplementary regulations.
